

St Paul said: "Pray without ceasing." What does this mean for us today?

Our prayer session on the Jesus Prayer begins with a story - taken from "The Way of the Pilgrim". Nobody knows who was the writer of this enchanting book. It is by a nameless Russian pilgrim who recounts his experiences as he wandered from one holy place to another in Russia and Serbia during the years preceding the liberation of serfs in 1861. His search for the secret of St. Paul's dictum "*Pray without ceasing*" was rewarded by the discovery of the power of the Jesus Prayer which is the real subject of this book. The pilgrim's manuscript was discovered in the late 1800s in possession of one of the monks at Mount Athos - a Greek monastery.

The Jesus Prayer has two major functions. First, the content and meaning of the prayer, "*Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner*", is a profound revelation of the Gospel itself. It is as if a genius has distilled the whole breadth and mystery of the Scriptures into one simple aphorism. Second, and supremely, the author shows us that the Jesus Prayer is a diligent yet direct means of encounter with the living Christ. It is a prayer so simple, yet so rich and totally God-absorbing that some Christians have made it their spiritual path literally to pray unceasingly the Jesus Prayer.

The Jesus Prayer has one aim and one aim only - to endow the person who says it with Christ-consciousness. The Fathers of the early Church encourage us to not only pray the Jesus Prayer but to live it so that it becomes the Prayer of the Heart.

Three Stages of Prayer

- 1. Oral prayer or prayer of the lips.
- 2. Mental prayer prayer said silently in the mind.
- 3. Prayer of the heart prayer is no longer something you do, but something you are. You are connected with the divine energies of God, and know that God dwells in the depths of your heart.

One spiritual writer has said: "One doesn't choose the Jesus Prayer, one is called to it by God." Whatever prayer we are called to, that is the best of us. So tonight we invite you only to open yourself to the Jesus Prayer. As it come to you, receive it and let the Lord lead you and show you what He wants.

Lord, Jesus Christ. There is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved. Saint Peter - Acts 4:12

Praying the Jesus Prayer

I invite you now to participate in praying the Jesus Prayer. First we will pray it aloud and together. Then we will continue to pray this prayer in silence

We pray this prayer in rhythm with our breathing "Lord Jesus Christ Son of God" on the IN breath "Have mercy on me a sinner" on the OUT breath.

Become aware of your breathing Aware of your breathing in and out Continue to do this for some moments

Now let us begin to pray the Jesus Prayer. We will begin, and you join in as you are ready, we will continue to pray this prayer for ten minutes, let yourself relax, let the prayer breathe itself within you.

Let us continue to pray this prayer now silently for some time

As you are ready let the Jesus Prayer cease Rest in the silence

Praying Jesus Name

To conclude: Let us spend time praying the name of Jesus over ourselves, our family and friends. His name is power strength healing.

The words of scripture say: "*His name is as oil poured forth*" Oil is used in blessing - Let us consciously bless each part of ourselves by praying the name of Jesus over each part of us, our mind ... our heart ... our eyes ... our mouth ... our ears ... let Him deeply bless us.

Now pray the name of Jesus over each person here.... your friends or family whose name comes to mind....

We pray with the faith of the woman who said - if only I can touch his cloak. Reach out in faith now as you pray His Name

Gently conclude your prayer And be present to this room





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
